Infrastructure Development Specialist – PIU (MSAN)

Background:

To help reverse the increase in stunting, the Government of Sindh has approved an Inter-Sectoral Nutrition Strategy of Sindh (INSS) in 2013. Multi-Sectoral Action for Nutrition (MSAN) (P158769) activities will focus on specific investments to improve behavior around the key areas of sanitation and hygiene and food consumption, but it will also support institutional and implementation arrangements that incentivize cross-sectoral collaboration to achieve nutrition results.

The Government of Pakistan has set ambitious targets for the next ten years by committing to reduce diarrheal cases by 50 percent while improving sanitation coverage from 74 percent to 90 percent and providing access to clean drinking water for all through Pakistan Vision 2025. Targets for food insecurity call for halving the current rate of 60 percent to 30 percent.

Objectives:

The Infrastructure Development **Specialist** will be based in Project Implementation Unit (PIU) Karachi, at the office of Multi Sectoral Actions for Nutrition (MSAN) which would be jointly managed by Local Government Department and Department of Agriculture, Government of Sindh.

Main Responsibilities:

- Assist and advise the Project in the design of Annual Work Plan within the structure of Results Framework and its relevant strategic objective(s) in consultation with the stakeholders specific to infrastructure development
- Ensure timely implementation of annual work plan under relevant strategic objective(s)
- Provide assistance in planning, implementation and supervision of construction activities through interlocution between relevant individuals and firms.
- Carry supervision, monitoring and technical coordination activities in particular by formulating program / project implementation strategy meeting program objectives and goal
- Provide necessary technical advice on suitability of facilities design; suggest necessary changes and forward recommendations for selection and approval of appropriate designs and prototype as proposed by firms or individual
- Monitor progress of all construction work.

- Provide technical review to Project of the payments on achievement of milestones as agreed in the contracts and certified by Project Design and Implementation Support Consultants (PDISC) to ensure timely release of payments to the contractors.
- Review the scope of work, approve design and lay out for the construction work and propose technical solutions where required; with support of PDISC
- Support Procurement Specialist in technical evaluation of bids and in drafting of contracts.
- Report problems encountered and suggest measures /remedies.
- Ensuring coordination and cooperation between the various stakeholders, at the Provincial and district Level.
- Preparing reports, briefs and monitoring progress.
- Provide inputs and materials to Communication Specialist for devising communication strategy, knowledge products and dissemination of results
- Prepare first drafts of BOQ (Bill of Quantity) till mobilization of PDISC;
- Other duties to be performed as per requirement of PMU process.
