### 'Implement ban on kite-flying threads'

ISLAMABAD: Despite a ban on metal and chemical coated kite-flying threads in the Hazara division, the sale is continued in all major areas endangering lives of not only those who use it but also of others. Citizens complained that many youths could be seen in various towns of Hazara division openly using chemical coated threads which has injured dozens of people including children. People, especially parents, have demanded the district administration to take strict action against violators and implement a ban on kite flying to ensure safety of residents.

### Police to set up narcotics control unit

ISLAMABAD: Senior Superintendent of Police (Operations) Dr Syed Masfuz Tanzeem on Friday said that Islamabad police would set up narcotics control unit to check menace of drug addiction and its supply. Addressing a press conference, he said that Islamabad police were committed to rooting out the menace of drug peddling and get rid of this evil. Narcotics control unit would be set up with the same purpose and violators would also take part in it. He said that police have speed up their efforts against drug-suppliers and arrested 132 accused in their recent campaign. He said that 77,123 gram of heroin, 50 kilogram hashish and 2788 gram of ice had been also recovered from these rabbed persons while 15 Nigerian nationals have been also arrested. A massive campaign against the menace of drug peddling in the city was already in progress, he said.

## Govt forms committee to settle land affectees' issue

### CDA says IHC verdict on compensating affected landowners will be fully implemented

ISLAMABAD: The federal cabinet has formed a high-level committee headed by Minister for Planning Asim Umar to implement the Islamabad High Court decision regarding the compensation to the affected local landowners of Islamabad.

The affected landowners had been waiting for compensation for decades in various sectors in Islamabad.

The Minister for Law and Justice Farooq Naseem, Minister for Human Rights Shireen Mazarri, Advisor to Prime Minister on Accountability Shehbaz Akbar will be the committee members. The cabinet said that the committee would look into the cases of the victims as per the IHC decision. The committee will also look into the cases of other victims. It will make recommendations for their solution and will also propose to the cabinet a policy on the construction of sectors in Islamabad.

## Water crisis deepens in Rawalpindi

Garrison city faces a daily shortfall of 13 million gallons of water

ISLAMABAD: The water supply from Khanpur Dam to Chakala Cantonment Board (CCB) is one MGD on alternate days while it is getting supplied two MGD from tube wells. The demand for CCB is around 30 MGD.

The densely populated areas of the city and cantonment, including Dikoh Syedpur, Dikoh Qufan, Siltans, Range Road, Dikoh Banaras, Dikoh Hassanabad, Tile Mohri, Gulistan Colony, Sir Syed Road, etc. are witnessing acute water shortage.

The Water and Sanitation Agency (WSA) currently has 45 MGD available daily from Khanpur and Rawal dams and its 450 tube wells. When contacted WSA Managing Director (MD) Raja Shaukat Mehmood said that it was no longer possible to increase the water problem of supply from tube wells and Khanpur and Rawal.

RCB spokesperson Qaiser Mehmood said that there is an enormous gap between demand and supply in the cantonment. However, the board is making efforts to supply water in all areas through better water management. CCB or Vice President Raja Irfan Ishaq said that the water crisis is intensifying in the cantonment areas.
